
## Math Bulletin Boards

#### **Fractions Board**

Objective: This board displays an example of how to write fractions along with a visual representation so it is easier for the kids to comprehend the material.

<u>Target Audience:</u> I think this would be for first or second grade because it is only simple fractions that this demonstrates.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This would probably take an hour at the most.




#### Math Vocab Board

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should take an hour at the most.




## Problem Solving Board

## Science Bulletin Boards

#### Scientific Method Board

<u>Target Audience:</u> I would use this in a fifth grade classroom, because that is when they start doing more advanced science assignments.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This may take about 30 to 45 minutes to complete.




### Solar System Board

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> I would say this board would take close to an hour.





#### Water Cycle Board

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This would probably take about an hour or so to make it look neat.




### **Cells Board**

<u>Approximate Prep Time:</u> This would take about 45 minutes.

#### Parts of Speech Board

<u>Objective:</u> This board shows what nouns, verbs, and adjectives mean, along with picture examples to help them understand it more.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This would be used in a third grade classroom.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should take around 30 minutes to complete.



# **Punctuation Board**

Objective: This board teaches the students all of the different punctuation that they can use in their writing and it explains when to use each one.

<u>Target Audience:</u> Probably kindergarten or first grade for when they start writing sentences.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should only take about 30 minutes.



#### Literary Elements Board

Objective: This teaches the students the different literary elements of a story when they are viewing different stories and the order of a plot, which will also help them when writing their own stories.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This is for fourth and fifth grade classrooms.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This would take about 30 to 40 minutes.



### **Editing Board**

Objective: This board reminds kids how to effectively edit their writing assignments and when to use lower and upper case letters, spaces, and punctuation to make their writing better.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This is for second and third graders.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This would take about 50 minutes.




# History Bulletin Board

#### Civil War Board

Objective: This board visually shows the different groups during the civil war on the map and also includes important people during that time period.

Target Audience: This would probably be used in 7th grade.

Approximate Prep. Time: This would probably take about 50 minutes.



#### Map of Events Board

<u>Objective:</u> This board would keep track of important events that the students would learn in each unit, and where they are located on the map.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This could be used by any grade and the information on it would be for that specific history class.

Approximate Prep. Time: This would probably take an hour to create the outline, and then the rest would be added over time.



## Revolution Timeline Board

Objective: This board is a timeline, which can be changed out for any time period. The board will help them remember what order events took place in.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This could be used in any history class and adjusted accordingly. This specific one is for 7th grade.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should take 30 minutes at most.




### **Current Events Board**

<u>Target Audience:</u> This can be used in any history class, probably in middle school.

Approximate Prep. Time: Should take 30 minutes at most, and the events can be changed out over time.



### Miscellaneous Bulletin Boards

#### **Daily Board**

<u>Objective:</u> This board has information that the students refer to every day, like the month and day, and the time and weather.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This is best for kindergarten and first grade classes.

Approximate Prep. Time: This would probably take an hour and a half or so because it is larger and more detailed.



#### Back to School Board

Objective: The purpose of this board is to make kids excited and welcomed into the classroom at the beginning of the year. It also shows how we are all one family.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This can be used in all classrooms, specifically elementary classes.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should take about 45 minutes.



### **Encouraging Board**

Objective: The purpose of this board is to remind the students that they can do what they set their mind to, and to make the class a more positive atmosphere.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This is a great board for elementary and middle school classrooms.

Approximate Prep. Time: This would probably take about 40 minutes at most.



#### **Display Board**

<u>Objective:</u> The purpose of this board is to show off and display the kids excellent work.

<u>Target Audience:</u> This board is best for elementary classrooms.

<u>Approximate Prep. Time:</u> This should take around 40 minutes.
